Senior Center Grand Opening & Ribbon Cutting

Haysville, KS – Mayor Bruce Armstrong is proud to announce the Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting for the newly built Senior Center. November 13, 2008 at 11:00 am a ribbon cutting is being held at the Center’s new location on 160 E. Karla.

Construction on the Center took less than a year and was made possible by a Community Development Block Grant and matching funds from the City. The new Senior Center is twice the size of the previous Center. The new Center will provide a growing senior population with more space for dinners, dances, and many other activities. The Center is located adjacent to the newly constructed Main Street Place, a senior housing complex. The existing senior citizen high rise, Peachtree Plaza, is located across the street.

A \$50,000 donation given by Sedgwick County has helped furnish the new Center with couches, automatic lift chairs, gaming boards, televisions, and a computer station area. The computers have already allowed Seniors to stay connected to family and loved ones, exchanging emails and pictures.

“The location for the new Senior Center will be much better for all of our senior residents,” Mayor Armstrong said. “The Senior Center, as well as much of Haysville’s expanding retail district will now be within walking distance for many of our seniors.”
