What is the Kansas PRIDE Program?

PRIDE is a volunteer, grassroots effort to improve the quality of life in the Haysville Community. PRIDE is dedicated to serving the community in making it a better place to live and work. Through the PRIDE program communities can identify what they would like to preserve, create or improve for their future and with the help of volunteers the ideal community future can be created.

What is the goal of PRIDE?

The goal of PRIDE is to help maximize community and economic development efforts by encouraging all groups to coordinate and work collaboratively for community betterment.

Projects of PRIDE

One of the most well known projects that Haysville PRIDE sponsors is the Annual City Wide Clean Up. This is done as a service for the citizens of Haysville in an effort to help keep the City clean. PRIDE relies on volunteers to help assist with picking up debris and money raised from the event goes towards other projects PRIDE helps fund. Citizens can purchase their permits from the Haysville library, with a portion of the proceeds donated to the Haysville Friends of the Library.

Haysville PRIDE also has their semi-annual bierock event. Twice a year anyone can purchase bierocks made by the PRIDE Committee and volunteers. Bierocks can be purchased by the dozen and are baked to perfection for your enjoyment. They can easily be warmed in the microwave any time. Proceeds go towards PRIDE projects.

Haysville PRIDE recognizes citizens for the care and pride they take in their property. Through nominations of property owners, PRIDE gives various awards such as the Yard of the Month and the Holiday House.

Haysville PRIDE has also been known to gather volunteers and help with community projects. Some of these projects include decorating the corner of Main & Grand with holiday decorations, and assisting with the installation of a gazebo located in the Historic District.
