City Releases New Haysville Eating Guide

Haysville, KS – The City of Haysville has completed a 2008 Eating Guide which showcases all of the eating establishments located in the City. The guide gives representation to fifteen businesses in Haysville, all of which someone could get anything from a quick bite to eat to a sit down meal.
