SNOW REMOVAL AND ICE CONTROL PROCEDURES

The City of Haysville will begin snow removal once four inches of snow has fallen or there are major drifts on the main traffic areas in the City.

Ice control will be on an as-needed basis during both ice storms and snow removal.

Unless there is an emergency, snow removal/ice control equipment will not be on the streets from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

The City has prioritized the streets for snow removal as to when streets will be cleared.

- 1st Main Traffic Areas
- 2nd School Bus Areas and Secondary Traffic Areas
- 3rd Perimeter Streets and General Residential Areas
- 4th Public Parking and Access

In severe weather conditions, the City concentrates more on the first priority streets due to the amount of equipment the City has to use. During priorities two and three, work equipment will return to priority one as needed.

During the snow removal process the excess snow may block your driveways. Please accept our apologies for this inconvenience. If you will wait to shovel your drive until after we have cleared the street, there will be less work involved for you.

When you see the trucks clearing the streets, please stay back 50 to 75 feet. Do not make sudden stops in front of the emergency equipment. It is extremely difficult for the equipment operator to make such abrupt stops. The City is doing its best to clear the roads and make it safe for you without anyone getting hurt in the process. Remember, drive smart in these conditions.

SNOW REMOVAL AND ICE CONTROL ROUTES

1st Priority

- (a) Grand Avenue from Broadway to the west City Limits
- (b) North and South Main to the City Limits or into the county area for a turn around

2nd Priority

- (a) Hungerford north to Timberlane Drive and Timberlane Drive south to Grand Avenue
- (b) Sarah Lane from Hungerford to North Main
- (c) North Lamar from Sarah Lane to Grand Avenue along with Castle Lane and Clinton Avenue from Sarah Lane to Castle Lane
- (d) Baughman to Hemphill to North Delos to Grand Avenue



3rd Priority

- (a) Perimeter streets such as Willow Lane from Meridian to Mimosa Drive and north to Alexander and east to the 100 block of Fager and east to North Main
- (b) 4th Street from Turtle to Ranger and north to Grand Avenue
- (c) Corey Street south from 63rd Street to Grover east to "A" Street north and west to Pleasant Street then north to 63rd Street
- (d) Hemphill east to Jane then south to Grand Avenue
- (e) Spencer to Wayne to Grand Avenue
- (f) Ward Parkway from Grand Avenue south to Diedrich to Broadway
- (g) Blossum into Orchard Acres and all roads within
- (h) Emmett Avenue to lift station

- (j) German from Grand to 7th Street
- (k) 7th Street from German to Turtle
- (l) 2nd Street from Van Arsdale to Meridian
- (m) Anita from North Main to Ivah to Alexander
- (n) Mimosa from Timberlane to Willow Lane
- (o) Sandalwood from Meridian to Timberlane
- (p) 65th Street from Seneca to Osage
- (q) Sunflower from Corey to 63rd Street
- (r) Ward Parkway from Grover to Sunflower Drive
- (s) Freeman from Jane to Marlen Drive
- (t) Marlen from Grand to Marlen Court
- (u) General cleaning of all other residential streets as needed.

4th Priority

- (a) City Building
- (b) Senior Center
- (c) City Library
- (d) Haysville Health Center (Nursing Home)
- (e) Bus Barn access—School District
- (f) Haysville Activity Center
