

The purpose of ordinance enforcement is to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Haysville. This purpose includes protecting neighborhoods against hazardous and deteriorating conditions that contribute to the degradation of neighborhood property values.

2. [What happens if I DO NOT come into compliance within the 5 day period, indicated in the Notice of Violation Letter?](#)

**Notice to Appear in Court:** All violations, including habitual or repeat offenders, could result in a Notice to Appear in Haysville Municipal Court if the violation is NOT brought into compliance within the designated time allotted. Violation of Haysville Municipal Code is a class C misdemeanor and each violation shall be constituted a separate offense subject to court costs of up to \$282.00, a fine of up to \$500.00 and/or one (1) month in custody, per violation per day. See Chapter 8, Article 4 and Chapter 17 of the Haysville Municipal Code for the fine schedule and penalties associated with nuisance violations.

**Abatement:** If bulky waste or tall grass and weed violations are not brought into compliance after the notification process the property will be abated by the city contractor and the cost will be billed to their yearly taxes.
