### **City of Haysville Updates Independence Day Festivities**

**Haysville, KS (July 1, 2020)** – The City of Haysville has made the following adjustments to our Independence Day Celebration in anticipation of Governor Laura Kelly’s executive order regarding masks being worn when in public places. It is recommended that masks be worn by participants whenever six feet of distance cannot be maintained.

#### **Independence Day Parade**

The parade will start at 8:00 a.m. at Haysville Middle School, 900 W. Grand Avenue. It ends at Haysville United Methodist Church at 601 E. Grand. Participant lineup begins at 7:15 a.m., and is on a first come, first served basis.

The parade will also be streamed live on the “City of Haysville Kansas” YouTube Channel.

Passing out candy, fliers, or trinkets IS NOT ALLOWED at the parade. Hugs, handshakes and high fives are not recommended. Social distancing for participants and spectators is strongly encouraged.
