City of Haysville Statement Regarding COVID-19

Haysville, KS (March 16, 2020) – The health and wellness of Haysville’s citizens, visitors, and staff is our highest priority. The City’s management team is in contact with local health authorities and is following guidance from the Centers for Disease Control, Kansas Department of Health and Environment, and the Sedgwick County Health Department.

Haysville citizens depend on city staff to provide essential services, including public safety services and the functions of our Public Works department. These vital services will continue with minimal modification.

Haysville Municipal Court has been cancelled for March 17th and 24th. Anyone who was scheduled to appear either day will receive written notice of the cancellation. Anyone needing to pay on a fine is encouraged to do so online at HaysvilleTix.com or via telephone at (800) 701-8560. Questions should be directed to the court clerk at (316) 529-5920.

The recycling center at Public Works, where Haysville residents can usually drop off brush, metal, concrete and mulch, is closed until further notice. Public Works encourages business transactions to be made by phone, email or fax whenever possible. Permit and license forms can be found at www.Haysville-ks.com/forms. The phone number at Public Works is (316) 529-5940, and the fax number is (316) 529-5945.

The Senior Center will remain open to allow for the distribution of noon meals for pre-registered Meals on Wheels and Friendship Meals recipients. The commodities distribution this Wednesday, March 18th will occur as scheduled, with some changes to the distribution procedure.

All activities and programs at the center have been cancelled indefinitely. The City of Haysville will continue to staff the Senior Center, so those citizens who count on the center as a trusted community resource can still seek guidance via telephone. Signage will be posted at the entryway of the center advising any visitor seeking entry to instead call the office at (316) 529-5903.

Changes are in effect at City Hall and the Haysville Activity Center as well. At City Hall, all business, including water bill payments, park shelter rentals and dog licenses is encouraged to be conducted by telephone or at the drive-up window located on the west side of City Hall. Signage is posted at the entryway of City Hall encouraging visitors to instead call the office at (316) 529-5900 or visit the drive-up window.

Haysville Recreation has cancelled Spring Break Camp, which was scheduled for March 16th - 20th, and refunds will be issued as quickly as possible. In addition, the Activity Center (HAC) is closed indefinitely starting at noon on Monday, March 16, 2020.

The City of Haysville will continue to keep a close eye on the situation and will provide updates or make changes as needed.
