Mayor's Youth Leadership Council to Host First Event

Haysville, KS (December 11, 2015) The students of the Mayor's Youth Leadership Council (MYLC) are hosting a Fine Arts Fair at the Haysville Activity Center on December 19th from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. The 17 member Council began in June under the leadership of Mayor Bruce Armstrong, and is made up of students from Campus High School and Haysville High School. Although various members of the group have already been out in the community volunteering at events put on by other community groups, the Fair is the first event coordinated by the MYLC. Members Avery Clough and Sydney Rodriguez are co-chairing the event.

The fair is open to artists of all ages and skill levels who work in a variety of mediums. "We want drawings, paintings, pottery, jewelry, quilts, sculptures, anything really. If it is art made by someone in Haysville, we want to showcase that," encouraged Clough. Submissions will be accepted until December 15th.

Clough, Rodriguez, and others from the MYLC will be visiting Haysville schools on Thursday, December 17th to pick up student art. Citizens can drop their creations off at the City Building, located at 200 W. Grand, as well.
