Meetings of Mayor's Youth Leadership Council Underway

Haysville, KS (June 29, 2015) Haysville Mayor Bruce Armstrong held the first meeting of his newly created Youth Leadership Council on Wednesday June 24th. The 19 member Council is made up of students from Campus High School and Haysville High School. The current members of the Council will serve from June 2015 to May of 2016. Students were selected for membership based on their answers to an essay application and their responses to a panel interview with Mayor Armstrong, Chief Administrative Officer Will Black and MYLC Consultant Carol Neugent.

“The Youth Leadership Council is truly a way to get young people involved in our community. They will be developing their own plan for events, community service and outreach,” said Mayor Armstrong. “We’ve got a great group of future leaders here. I’m excited to see what they do with this opportunity.”

Wednesday’s meeting agenda included many different team building exercises, an introduction to various City leaders, and preliminary work on council bylaws. The Council discussed participation standards and decided upon which officers would be needed to help them run smoothly. They will meet twice more during the summer, to finalize their bylaws and to hold elections for officers.
