KDHE Announces Public Availability Session for Former American Cleaners Groundwater Contamination

TOPEKA, Kan. –The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) announces a Public Availability Session (PAS) to update residents on the extent of contamination attributed to the former American Cleaners site in Haysville, Kansas. The PAS for the KDHE Dry Cleaner Remediation Program is scheduled for **6:00 pm on Tuesday, December 5, 2017 at the Haysville Middle School Gymnasium** located at 900 West Grand Avenue, Haysville.

The PAS will include:

- An update on the water main installation progress in the area of concern
- A timeline for completing installation of water mains
- The process for completing water connections to each residence
- A timeline to complete connections to residences

After the update, KDHE will facilitate a question and answer session for any concerns that residents may have.

Residents in the *Area of Concern* near the former American Cleaners site at 412 West Grand Avenue, outlined on the map attached below, are encouraged to attend the session.
