

Dog Park Rules

1. Park hours are from 5:00 a.m. to midnight.
2. Dog must have collar with current rabies tag and be current on vaccinations.
3. Dogs must be leashed when entering/leaving the fenced area and leash must be readily available at all times while within the park.
4. Owners must maintain control of the dog, and be physically capable of keeping their dog under reasonable control at all times.
5. No more than 3 dogs are allowed per visitor.
6. Dogs in heat, sick or deemed dangerous by the Haysville City Code are prohibited.
7. Dogs must be neutered or spayed.
8. No spiked or pinch collars.
9. No animals other than dogs allowed.
10. No food, rawhide chews, alcoholic beverages, glass containers, littering, skateboards, motorbikes, bicycles, or rollerblades allowed.
11. Tobacco use is only allowed (including vaping) in the parking lot.
12. Owners are responsible for picking up and disposing of their dogs waste in the collection containers provided.
13. Professional dog training is not allowed.
14. Areas are designated for use of "small" and "all" dogs. Small dogs are < 45 lbs.
15. Large dogs > 45 lbs. are not allowed into the small dog area.
16. Animal bites should be reported by calling 911.
17. Owners assume all risks, loss or injury for themselves or their dog(s) associated with or resulting from the use of the park.
18. Owners are responsible for injuries caused by their dogs to other persons and dogs. The City of Haysville shall be held harmless for any damage caused by a dog.
19. Owners must immediately restrain their animal and/or leave the park when instructed to do so by any law enforcement officer or City employee.
20. Violations or park rules may result in removal from the park or a citation as established in Chapter 17 of the Haysville City Code.
21. The rules are established pursuant to Chapter 12 of the Haysville City Code.
